

Conference on ‘Economic Security & Market Regulation’ June 13, 2025

The *Sino-German Centre (SGC)* and the *Frankfurt Competence Centre for German and Global Regulation (FRRC)* at *Frankfurt School of Finance & Management* organised the conference on “Economic Security and Market Regulation” on 13 June at Frankfurt School jointly with the *Europa-Institute of Saarland University*. In times of rising geopolitical tensions and economic fragmentation, the conference is a forum that emphasizes the increasing importance of geoeconomics from a European perspective.

The keynote speeches had been held by Thorsten Schäfer-Gümbel, CEO of the Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) and the Consul General of China in Frankfurt, HUANG, Yiyang. A special senior talk with Jörg Wuttke from the Albright Stonebridge Group and Rudolf Scharping, former defence minister of Germany, to the topic ‘Europe Needs Strategic Clarity’ was moderated by Roland Koch, the former prime minister of the State of Hesse and currently Professor at Frankfurt School. Four panels with high-level speakers on the topics of the EU pillars of economic security like Risk Assessment, Promote, Protect, and Partnering, completed the programme.
